 Impact Point: 17.89

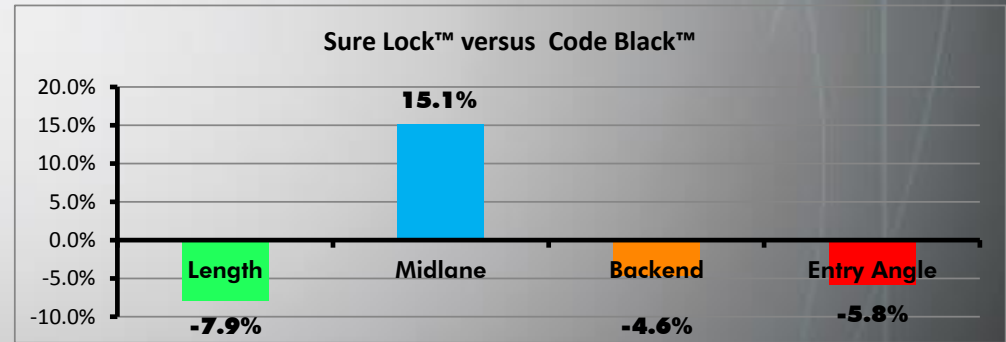


**Code Black™**  
 R2S™ Pearl Reactive  
 1500-grit Polished  
 RAD4™ Core

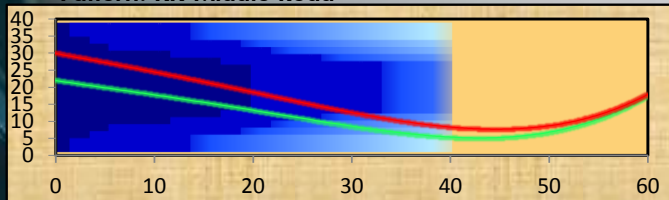


→ **Code Black™**  
 Laydown: 21.95  
 Launch Angle: -2.30°  
 Break Point: 43.00'  
 Impact Point: 17.48

- The Sure Lock laydown was 8 boards deeper than Code Black.
- The Sure Lock generated about 15% more midlane read.
- The Code Black gave about 8% more length.
- Both balls finished high flush.
